H10L, D10L - marked with strips, for children not accompanied by

HDR - marked with strips, for children with parents

P - "entry of the day", for beginners (about 3km)

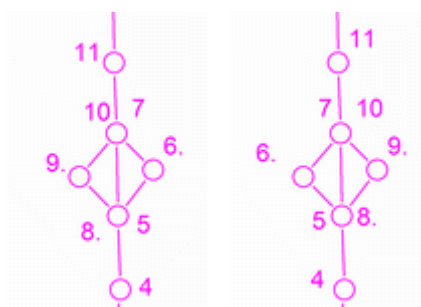
T3, T6 - "entry of the day" (about 2 and 4 km on saturday and 3 and 6  
km on sunday, regular courses, not suitable for beginners)

Competitors in P, T3, T6 and HDR classes choose their start time at  
registration of the day (HDR from start time 50).

**DH20A and** D18A, D20A, H18A and H20A classes have 1 loop during sundays race.

**DH18A classes:** Competitors starting on even rank run through the loop in different  
sequence compared to those on odd rank. That's why competitors in these  
classes are seperated into subclasses 1 and 2 in start list: D18A1 and  
D18A2, D20A1 and D20A2, H18A1 and H18A2, H20A1 and H20A2.  
Competitors are responsible for taking the righth control descriptions in  
CC and also the righth map on start according to their subclass. In case  
competitor takes wrong map on start, or runs through the loop in different  
direction, he would be disqualified.

Example of control sequence in the loop in the subclasses:



- Class lengths:** On web pages of the competition and in CC.
- Terrain:** Miscellaneous terrain in the very neighbourhood of Nature reserve Sumava. In some parts rocks and boulder formations, more or less easily penetrable forest, in some parts marshy areas and also highland forest with less contour details. Altitude 580 – 845m.
- Maps:** Saturday 6.6. - Kustrý 1:10000, E = 5m, size A4  
 Sunday 7.6. - Zahajeny 1:15000 (DH16-DH45), 1:10000 (other classes), E = 5m, size A3 (1:15 000) / A4 (1:10 000)  
 authors : J. Boruvka, R. Horky, chief cartographer M. Lejsek  
 spring 2009, maps will be waterproof for all classes  
 The area was never mapped before.
- Special map features:** Green circle: distinctive tree  
 Green cross: root stock  
 Brown cross: small platform  
 Black cross: other object (camping place) Violet cross-hatched diagonal lines (710 Dangerous area): impassable fallen trees
- Registration:** Friday 19:00 - 21:00 in ZS Lerchova, Susice  
 Saturday (middle distance) 9:00 - 11:00 in the competition center  
 Sunday (long distance) 7:30 - 8:30 also in the CC
- Accommodation:** According to demand of competitors, closer information in the team envelopes (registration).
- Parking (CC):** On a meadow north from village Zalesi - access from Zalesi (follow the organizers directions. Parking fee 20CZK for each day.

- Start 00:** Saturday (middle distance) 12:00  
 Sunday (long distance) 9:30
- The way to the start will be marked by blue and white ribbons.  
 In case of rain, it will be possible to leave your dress on sunday start, we will bring it to the competition center.  
 There will be available two mobile WC cabins on the way to sunday start.  
 On sunday, there will be also water available on the start.
- Start bibs:** DH21E, DH16A, DH18A and DH20A classes will run with start bibs. Competitors will take their bibs according to start list at the start and

return it in the finish.

- Sportident:** All classes will use electronic punching system Sportident. Competitors with their own SI-card will have to fill in number of their SI-card in the entry, others may borrow SI-card from the organizer for 40 CZK/day. If lost, compensation 700 CZK/pc will be required.  
Every competitor in the start corridor will do as follows:  
1. clear the SI card (time -3 minutes)  
2. check the clearing of the SI card (time -2 minutes)  
Maps are situated a couple of metres behind the starting line.  
When course controls don't work (they should beep and blink), punch your map into prepared field and show your map in the finish to the head referee or other charged person.
- Control descriptions:** Control description cards of each class will be available in the CC. The control descriptions are neither at the start nor on the maps!
- Out of bounds areas:** It is forbidden to trespass fences (signs n. 522 and n.524) and settlement (sign n. 527).  
Breaking these rules leads to disqualification !
- Spectator control:** DH16A-20A and DH21E classes have a spectator control on the saturday race course (middle distance).
- Time limit:** Saturday (middle distance) 90 minutes  
Sunday (long distance) 180 minutes
- Finish:** Competitor finishes the race by punching the finish SI unit and reading his SI card at the SI reading control. It is obligatory even if you quit the race. Competitors with SI cards provided by organizer return them after finishing 2nd day course at the SI reading control.  
You have to hand over your map in the finish area into a team bag, and you will get it back after the start of the last runner of sunday race (will be announced in the CC).
- Results:** Preliminary results will be posted in the CC. Official results will be available on web pages of the competition after the end of the competition.
- Protests:** All protests present to the main referee with 200 CZK deposit.

- Awards:** The prize giving ceremony of the saturday race will be hld at the CC aproximately at 17:00, and of the sunday race at 15:00 (exact times will be determined at the CC).  
Awards for the best in DH14C, DH16B, DH18B, DH20B, DH21B a DH21C classes, and for the best 3 runners in other classes. No awards in P, T3 and T6 classes.
- First aid:** In the finnish of the races (in the CC during both days).
- WC:** Mobile toilets in the CC (Toi Toi).  
There will be available two other cabins on the way to sunday start.
- Washing:** There will be a tank with water and washbasins in the CC.  
The water is not potable !
- Refreshment:** Water with juice will be available on longer courses of the sunday race

(on courses with winner times more then 50 minutes approximately every 30 minutes), and in the finish of both days.

Water on the start of sunday race.

Buffet in the CC.

**Other sale:** There will be stalls with orienteering and outdoor equipment in the CC.

**Crèche:** Crèche (kindergarten) available in the CC.

**Notice:** Competitors take part in O-event on their own risk.

**Warning:** Most of the courses cross a minor road passing through the competition area. Even though it's not much-frequented please pay increased attention when crossing it.

The courses lead across areas with high cliffs, please pay increased attention not to fall from one.

There are violet cross-hatched diagonal lines (710 Dangerous area) used in the map. It presents impassable fallen trees. They do not present any danger.
